If you're heading to Disney with kids, there's one thing we can say with full confidence: **little legs get tired**. Even kids who never use a stroller at home may suddenly need one after miles of walking, long waits, and full park days.

And when legs get tired...tough moods can follow.

That's when a stroller stops being "extra" and starts being essential.

In this guide, we are looking at the top ten best-selling, most popular single

and double strollers available on Amazon, and then comparing them to the qualifications you can find below.

Use this guide as a reference before your trip. Skim it, save it, come back to it when you need it.

Tired legs shouldn't derail your Disney magic – and a well-used stroller can quietly save the day.

Ultimately, what stroller is best for YOU will depend on your family's needs and wants, but hopefully this guide can help you get started on your search!

STROLLER SIZE & WDW TRANSPORTATION RULES



Stroller Size Limit

The stroller size limit in WDW is: **Max 31" wide and 52" long.**

Prohibited Items

Wagons, stroller wagons, and folding wagons are prohibited.

Note that one PlanDisney response specifies "this rule includes any type of wagon, whether it's pulled like a traditional Radio Flyer wagon or pushed like a convertible Keenz stroller wagon."

There *may, however*, be situations where certain wagons *may* be allowed to enter in special circumstances where the wagon is needed for transportation due to a disability.

Monorail

- Single strollers are often allowed open.
- Tandem double strollers are often allowed open.
- Generally, side-by-side strollers *can* roll onto the monorail without having to be folded if they meet Disney's general size specifications (31 inches wide or smaller and 52 inches long or smaller). BUT some side-by-side doubles may need to be folded depending on size and how full the cart is.
- Depending on how full the cart is, other strollers may also need to be folded.



Buses/Trams

Strollers must be folded. The child must sit in a seat on this kind of transportation.



Skyliner

- Single strollers are often allowed open.
- Tandem double strollers are often allowed open.
- All side-by-side doubles generally must be folded.
- In general, note that strollers taken on the Disney Skyliner must be 30" or narrower to fit within the Skyliner doors.



Boats

- The large Magic Kingdom Ferryboats (which take guests between the Transportation and Ticket Center and Magic Kingdom) do not require you to fold up your stroller.
- The smaller Water Taxis/Resort Launches vary. Technically, Disney's rules say "All strollers must be folded and stowed out of the aisle." But you may find certain things can depend on the watercraft.



Escalators

Strollers are not allowed on escalators.



STROLLER DETAILS & PRO TIPS

- 1 Strollers are NOT allowed in most queues.** You park them in the designated stroller parking areas near the attractions you're headed to.
- 2 Strollers are NOT allowed in most restaurants,** but occasionally, Cast Members will make exceptions for sleeping children.
- 3 Cast Members do sometimes need to move strollers around to make more room.** Do not be surprised if you park your stroller in one spot, come back, and discover that it's not in the exact spot you left it. Search the entire stroller area – a Cast Member likely moved it around while arranging the strollers. **Having something distinct on your stroller makes it easier to spot!**
- 4** Even if it's not raining when you park your stroller, you might want to **put the cover on,** storms can come on fast!
- 5** When entering a park, **expect a quick check of the under-basket and pockets at the entrance.** Kids **DO need to get out if they are not sleeping and are big enough.**
- 6** When going through security, **hold out metal objects** (like umbrellas, water bottles, etc.) or leave them easily visible in the basket of the stroller so it's quicker to get through security.
- 7** When going through security, typically **one person will go with the stroller through security** while everyone else goes through the regular line

MY KID IS 8, DO I REALLY NEED A STROLLER?

Yes. Disney is huge. We're talking miles of walking every day. A stroller gives them a place to rest, zone out, or even grab a quick nap, which means fewer tired feet, fewer meltdowns, and a much happier day for everyone. It's not about age – it's about saving your trip from exhaustion.

SHOULD WE DO HAVE TWO SINGLE STROLLERS OR ONE DOUBLE STROLLER?

It depends on your family – but for **Disney, two single strollers are usually easier.** They're simpler to maneuver through a crowd and give you the flexibility to split up if needed. A double can work, but singles tend to make the day feel smoother.

A double stroller can be helpful if you want to keep both kids together and all your gear in one place. It's easier for one adult to push, gives you a single spot for snacks and supplies, and works well when both kids need to rest or nap at the same time. It can also make it easier to keep track of everyone in busy areas since no one is splitting off.



SHOULD WE RENT A STROLLER IN DISNEY OR BRING OUR OWN?

Bringing your own can be really beneficial. The Disney strollers you rent in-park are park-only, so your kid still has to walk to and from the park (or be carried). Having your own stroller can make early mornings and late nights way easier.
